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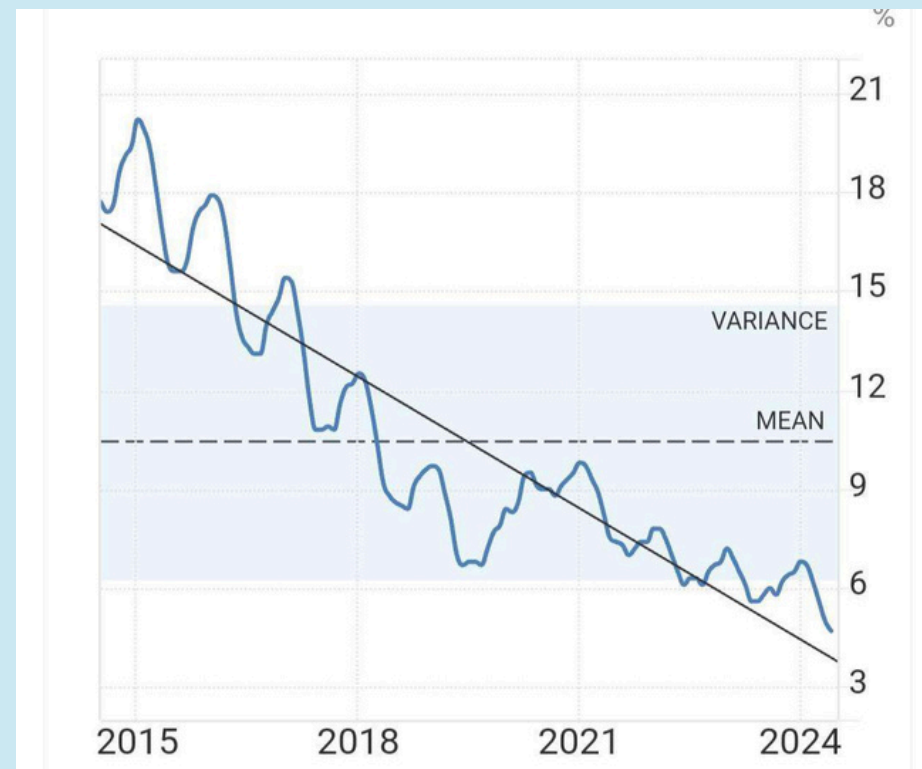
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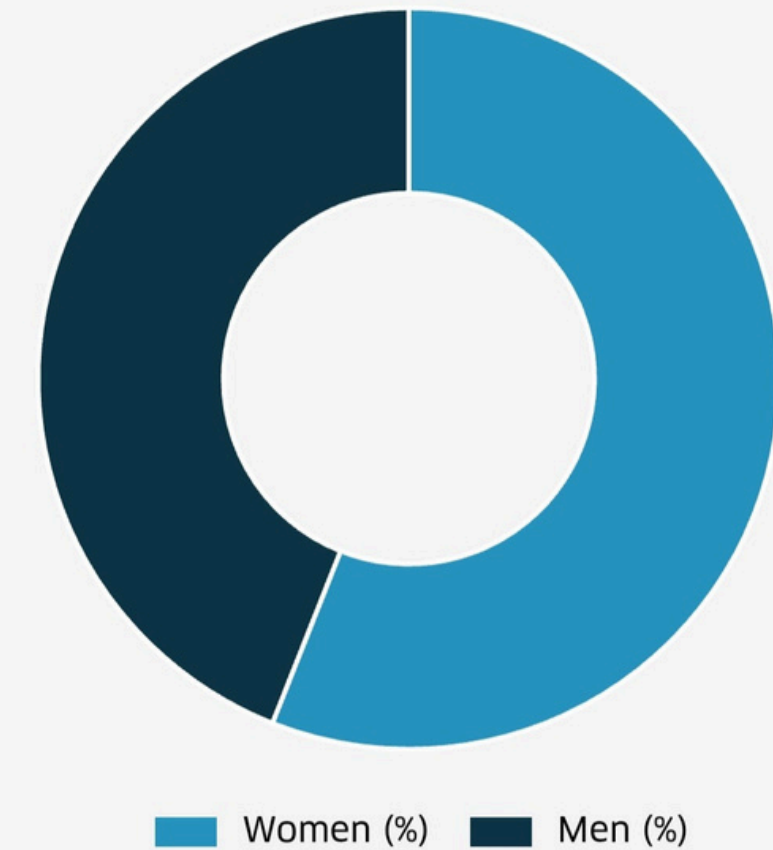
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General INFORMATION

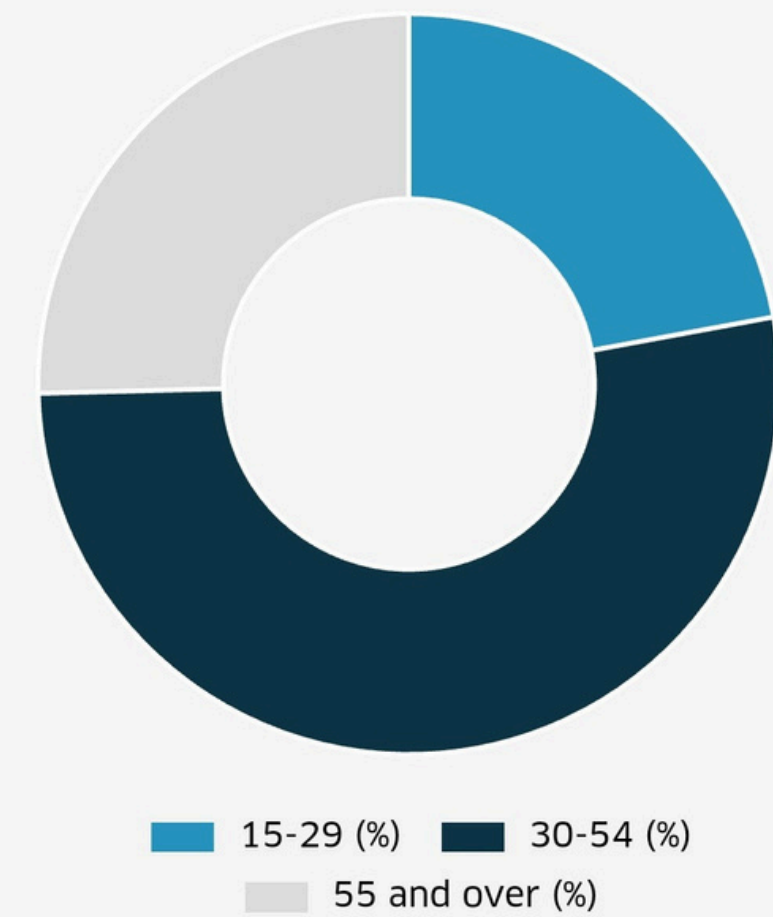
- unemployment rate: 5,5%

Factors influencing **UNEMPLOYMENT**

- lack of skilled workforce in certain sectors (IT and engineering)
- complex legal frameworks can deter entrepreneurship and foreign investments
- burden on businesses and employees, potentially affecting job creation
- low workforce mobility and insufficient motivation to adapt to the market needs
