- Wages across 4 Quarters have been steadily increasing.
- Average Wage across the 4 Quarters in 2022 was €20,980
- Average Wage across the 4 Quarters in 2023 was €22,055
- This represents a 5.12% Increase in wages from 2022 to 2023.







Unemployment

- The unemployment rate has marginally gone down.
- Over a span of 10 years between 2013 and 2023, the Population has risen from 425,384 to 542,051 but the Average Unemployment Rate has decreased from 2.78% in 2013 to 1.76% in 2023

% Population in Malta 2013




% Population in Malta 2023
